Byron South Sidewalk Connectivity Plan

March 8th, 2019

Dear Property Owners, Tenants, and/or Business Owners,

The City of London is planning to install sidewalks on the west side of Blake Street, from the end of the existing sidewalk on Byron Baseline Road to the end of the existing sidewalk on Lola Street within the City's property limits, see attached map on the following page.

Staff completed an assessment of potential impacts and mitigation strategies to determine which side of the street would cause the least amount of disruption for the installation of a sidewalk. The evaluation included potential impacts to trees, existing utilities, driveways, etc. This sidewalk will provide a connection along a missing link that will improve accessibility and mobility in the community for all users.

Currently, City staff are working on the detailed design and contract documents for this project. The anticipated construction period for this sidewalk project is summer 2019, with a construction schedule of approximately five weeks. Sidewalks promote active lifestyles and help create an accessible community and sustainable city.
