Re: Lambeth Optimist Park – Proposed Park Improvements

The City of London will be upgrading amenities in Lambeth Optimist Park, located at 4200 Campbell Street North (please see enclosed map) or visit london.ca/parkconstruction).

Improvements to this park include the renovation and relocate the existing mosquito size baseball diamond further to the east and north, constructing a new pathway connection to Bakerville Street, replacing many of the existing pathways, removal of hazard trees and those in conflict with the new diamond as well as tree planting throughout the park. Please see the enclosed concept plan on the reverse of this page.

Construction for this project is expected to start in September 2021. Please note that the schedule is dependent on weather conditions.

*Accessibility: proposed pathways are considered a 'Recreational Trail' under the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*, and would meet all technical requirements for accessibility including minimum width, maximum slope, and head clearance space. As part of this project, the City of London is inviting feedback from residents with various disabilities on their specific needs regarding recreational trails and outdoor play spaces.*
